The Port of Los Angeles, the largest in the United States, today was hit by a strike of drivers demanding better pay, announced activists. More than a hundred of port truckers from four of the leading transport companies in Los Angeles and Long Beach began the 48 hour strike for better benefits. The protesters demanded an end to violations of workers' rights and have widespread and illegal misclassification as "independent contractors."
